# Mammography QUICK FACTS

At Johns Hopkins Medicine's **Sullivan Breast Center**, we strive to provide the highest quality breast care through early detection. Our radiologists are medical experts dedicated to breast imaging, and our team is focused on your care. We're conveniently located at Sibley Memorial Hospital in Washington, D.C.

#### What you need to know about mammograms:

- Annual mammograms are the best way to detect breast cancer early. Early detection leads to less morbidity and better survival rates.
- 3D tomosynthesis mammography is available for all of our patients and allows us to analyze the breast tissue 1mm view at a time, providing more detail and potentially earlier detection of breast cancer.

#### When and how often to get mammograms:

- According to the Society of Breast Imaging, women at average risk for breast cancer should begin getting annual mammograms at age 40.
- Always talk with your doctor about when to start getting mammograms. Breast cancer screening should be tailored to each woman.
- Women who have a family history of breast cancer or genetic factors such as a mutation of the BRCA gene, generally start screening earlier.
- Our high-risk clinic helps to determine the most appropriate screenings, including breast MRI.


